

Transitions to high school – why is it important?

The leap from primary into secondary school presents a period of rapid change for children. The expectations and environment are vastly different, as students are required to be more independent, mature and organised. Stepping into high school for the first time can be a very daunting experience for some students, especially if it is their first exposure to timetables, navigating the grounds, being independent and having a high level of organisational skills.

We have developed a Transition and Enrichment Program that runs throughout the upper primary school years to support our new students and make sure their transition to our school is as smooth as possible. Activities and events are held throughout the year to support students to build their academic capacity, organisational and study skills, develop strong peer relationships, enhance resilience and mindfulness, and to build a sense of connectedness to the school community.

Immersion Days

Year 5 students will have the opportunity to experience a range of curriculum-based activities which include the Arts, Agriculture, ITD, Home Economics, Science and Digital Technologies. This day is beneficial for all students to attend as it gives the students a variety of high school experiences which will help them and their families to make their decisions around which high school to enrol in. Transition Day

The transition from Year 6 to 7 is both a social and academic turning point for adolescents, which can impact on both their engagement in learning and their wellbeing. For students, the move from primary school to a more challenging environment with new procedures, new types of learning activities and new peer relationships can lead to them feeling vulnerable and potentially disengaged. Our current Transition Day program and Team Building Day for Year 7 students can help minimise negative impacts on engagement and wellbeing, assist students to develop resilience and help them to make a successful transition from primary to secondary schooling. Transition Day is typically held on the second last Monday of Term 4. See the appendix 2 for a sample program.

Faculty Visits

Faculty visits are a good opportunity for students to experience subject that they will undertake at Dakabin SHS. This will allow year 6 students moving into year 7 to make informed decisions on whet subjects they would like to undertake and select electives that they are interested in.
